What can I expect on the shoot?

During the shoot, we'll hang out in Scotland's stunning scenery and have some fun with your dog creating everlasting memories. I know lots of good spots!

I'll capture their personality and your bond with them in a relaxed, natural way - they don't know they are being a supermodel!

We can work with your dog on or off lead, so don't worry if your furry friend needs to be on the lead at all times. Leads will be edited out during post production, and don't worry if your pet doesn't want to sit or we have to give them lots of breaks in between snapping - that's to be expected!

We want this to be a stress free experience for them (and you), so we will just 'be more dog' and live in the moment!
It doesn't matter if we have to set up the shot more than once.
Remember - I have unlimited patience for pets! We will get plenty of photographs for you to choose from, I promise!

Frequently Asked Questions



What if it rains or I need to reschedule?

It's Scotland! There's a good chance of rain (it was raining when I took this photo of Odie). As long as it's not blowing a gale or a torrential downpour, we should be ok. In fact, moody weather makes for better shots than bright sunshine.

I will be in touch with you in the lead up to the session so, if there are any unforeseen circumstances, rescheduling shouldn't be a problem.

My dog can't be off-lead? Is that ok?

Of course! I can remove leads from any ordered images.

If your dog wears a harness, I recommend wearing that to come to the location but if there is any way to have your dog in a flat collar for the photos that would look better. You can also bring a long lead for action shots.

Can I be in the picture?

Of course you can!

Where will we have our session?

I have lots of stunning locations up my sleeve where we won't have to walk too far to get great shots - from majestic mountain backdrops to lochs and beaches.

What if my dog doesn't want to sit?

That's ok! While it's always a good idea to work on your dog's stay behaviour before our session, I can guarantee you that I have worked with dogs that were more challenging than yours! I have plenty of tricks up my sleeve to create engaging images no matter the obedience level of your pup.

Can I bring extra dogs or children to our session?

It's best not to (unless we are doing a shoot with two or three dogs from the same family). The less distractions, the better. Nice calm energy levels are what we are after for an enjoyable photo experience.

We will meet again about a week after our session at your home, a local cafe or via Zoom so we can go over all of the images, and you can choose your favourites before we finalise your order. Your files will then move into the post production stage, where I will work some magic and transform them into one of a kind artwork that you can treasure forever.

Preparing for the session - some tips:

- Exercise your dog prior to the shoot but not too much that they have had to cool down in a puddle!
- I always have a stash of Scooby snacks, but if your dog has any dietary restrictions please bring some of their favourite treats.
- If your dog has any favourite toys, bring them too.
- If possible, bring a regular flat collar. If you need the harness for walking we can change into the flat collar once we are on location. Leads can be removed in post processing but not harnesses.
- If you use a groomer, I recommend visiting a couple of days prior to the shoot, especially if your pup needs the hair around their eyes trimmed. We want to see their beautiful eyes so let's get any stray hairs tidied up.
- Be prepared for the weather!


